### 3 Changes Since Version 2.1.0

#### *Kerio Workspace Client*

- fixed potential crash when closing the client window
- fixed memory leak in file synchronization
- fixed failure to quit the app on OS X, blocking logout
- optimization of file upload
- fixed endless synchronization loop when files are stored on network file system
- optimized server load when synchronizing thousands of files

#### *Administration*

- fixed errors during cleanup of deleted files in database
- disabled changing log highlighting rules for users with read-only access
- fixed listing active user sessions
- fixed storing SMTP password

## 4 About Kerio Workspace

Kerio Workspace is a business server software solution that helps teams spend less time looking for documents and files and more time collaborating on them. Fully managed through a web browser, its simple design provides mobile access to shared documents, text, multimedia content and more, from anywhere, on any device.

### ***Warning!***

Upgrade from earlier versions of Kerio Workspace will migrate the data store to a new database schema. Downgrade back to previous versions is not possible. Please don't forget to backup your data store before installing this version.

Upgrade from some earlier versions can also trigger rebuilding the whole full-text search index. This is a process that is very CPU intensive and can take up to several hours. Users can work with the server during the reindexing, but the server can be slow, and full-text queries will return incomplete results.

## 5 What's New in Version 2.1?

### ***Major UI Design Update***

We did a complete UI graphic redesign. The user interface now has a much more beautiful look and feel.

### ***External Sharing***

Share your pages with external users. Create a permanent link to any page and send it to anyone - they will be able to see the page without having account in Workspace and without logging in. There is also an optional protection of the link with a password.

### ***Table Component***

Workspace now has a new table component, providing everything you need from a decent spreadsheet. Editing tables, adding and removing columns and rows, powerful formulas with many functions.

### ***Image Gallery Component***

Upload your photos into an image gallery. Photo thumbnails are directly embedded in the page, and there is a powerful slideshow mode.

### ***Improved UI of Kerio Workspace Client***

If you are synchronizing many file libraries at once, the UI of the Kerio Workspace Client is now much cleaner and easier to understand. Synchronized libraries are grouped by space, and all libraries on one page are visible together as parts of one list view.

## **6 Installation and Configuration**

This version of Kerio Workspace can be installed on the following operating systems:

- Windows XP SP2 and newer
- Mac OS X 10.6 (Snow Leopard), 10.7 (Lion) or 10.8 (Mountain Lion). Only Macs with Intel processors are supported
- Linux: Debian 6.0, Ubuntu 10.04 LTS or 12.04 LTS, Red Hat Enterprise Linux 6, CentOS 6.0, openSUSE 11.0-11.3, SUSE Linux Enterprise 11 SP 2. Only 32-bit distributions are supported
